Accelerated Freefall (AFF) is the course for those who are really serious about becoming a Qualified Skydiver. It is particularly intensive to allow rapid progression to become a British Parachute Association (BPA) Category 8 Qualified Solo Skydiver.

Throughout the course you will receive personal tuition from two BPA qualified Instructors, who will provide direct practical assistance. Your Instructors will accompany you in freefall, assessing and improving your performance moment by moment, giving you both time and help to gain confidence.

The course commences with a full day of ground tuition with your Instructors. This covers theory and practice of Skydiving and the use of your parachute system. You will learn safety procedures, how the equipment operates, how to exit the aircraft with your Instructors, how to maintain control and communication in freefall, how to initiate the opening sequence of the main parachute and how to steer down to the landing area and land safely. Before your jump, you will practice all the procedures for both your Skydive and the parachute descent until your Instructors are completely satisfied with your abilities.

When your Instructors are happy with your performance on the ground, you will make your Level 1 Skydive from 13,000ft, both of the Instructors will exit the plane holding onto you. They will continue to coach you during freefall using a system of hand signals. So we can assist you after the parachute has opened you will be fitted with a ground to air radio. After every AFF Skydive, a comprehensive debrief takes place with your instructors, followed by additional training both to improve skills learnt already and add those required for the next Skydive.



The equipment provided is the very latest Ram Air Parachute System, fitted with an Automatic Activation Device. You will also be provided with a Jumpsuit, Goggles, Helmet and Altimeter. We advise that you wear comfortable loose clothing and a good pair of training shoes.

Before you enplane your Instructors will double check all the parachute systems and will sign a checklist to state you are safe to Skydive. On jump run at 13,000ft your Instructors will again check your equipment as a matter of safety before you exit.

Skydiving is a very weather dependant sport and due to the intense nature of the training you are advised to ensure that you can jump on a pre-planned and regular basis. If good weather conditions prevail you could complete your whole course within a few days, but you must be aware that the weather is not always favourable. Should you be unable to complete your pre-determined Skydives we can arrange a convenient date for you to complete your course.

Skydiving has it's restrictions and unfortunately we can't train anyone who is:-

- Under 16 years of age.
- Persons over 16 but under 18 years of age must have written parental/guardian consent.
- Over the age of 55 years.
- Over 15 stone in weight fully clothed.
Please note: You will be weighed to ensure this requirement is adhered to.
- Overweight for your age, sex or height. Should your Body Mass Index (BMI) not be in proportion to your weight and height you are at more risk of suffering an injury.

Persons involved in Skydiving should have a reasonably high standard of fitness as this will assist in your ground and freefall training. *In the interest of SAFETY, if you are unable to absorb the training and/or cannot react safely to any given situation that you are taught, your Instructors reserve the right to refuse anyone from making their Skydives.*

The cost of a Full AFF Course is £1400.00. Freefall video maybe available upon request at an additional cost. We also offer Level 1 AFF which is the AFF ground School and One Skydive for a cost of £375.00. Should you wish to enrol on a Full AFF Course or Level 1 Only please complete the attached booking form and send with the appropriate booking fee to the address in the bottom right hand corner of the page. **All booking fees are non-returnable.**

ACCELERATED FREEFALL TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please review our terms and conditions before booking your training and jump or before purchasing flight tickets. If you make a booking or perform any other transaction with NWPC Ltd (Skydive Northwest) either directly or through an agent, you will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions and they form the basis of your contract with NWPC Ltd (Skydive Northwest).

- A booking, once made is final and all deposits are NON Refundable. Balance of payment is due on or before the day of the course. Once paid monies are non refundable for any reason. You will not be allowed to change the date with less than 21days notice and a £15.00 admin fee will be charged for changing the date once agreed. Anyone failing to turn up on the day of their booking will lose the value of the deposit paid.
- The centre reserves the right to cancel and / or re-arrange any pre booked course subject to minimum numbers not being attained, aircraft maintenance or staff shortages or for any other reason. You must comply with the Centre's rules for your own safety. Suitability of any person jumping will be made by the Chief Instructor at the centre and being accepted for training does not entitle you to jump from an aircraft if we deem you to be unfit or in any way unsuitable.
- If taking part in RAPS or AFFF training please study the height/weight chart on your medical declaration form, as persons unfit or over weight relative to their height cannot be accepted for training.
- If bad weather prevents you jumping a refund will not be given. You will be offered a new date to try and jump which is mutually convenient. It will be up to you to return to the centre on another occasion or occasions to complete your jump. In case of bad weather, you will be rebooked at no additional cost.
- If you arrive without paperwork in order, i.e. over the weight limit, or declaration of fitness not stamped, you will not be allowed to jump and the you may forfeit your activity and all monies paid. No alcohol must be consumed before or while training or before skydiving.
- Gift receipts maybe transferred on approval by the centre but are **not refundable**. Once a gift receipt has been issued you have twelve months to redeem it. If it is not redeemed within the twelve month period the gift will no longer be valid. A £50.00 fee is charged to extend any gift receipt for a maximum of 6 months. If you book a date to redeem your gift receipt and don't turn up for your course, the gift will be deemed used
- If booking as a group and some of the group don't turn up on the day, deposits are not transferable and the non group price will be charged. If you fail to turn up on the day of your course you will still be liable for the balance of payment.
- Any person attending to undertake any training course and subsequent jump must become a member of the British Parachute Association (BPA). The membership is for 12 months and provides legal liability cover for **Third Party Risks Only** and provides no cover for personal accident, injury or death. Once purchased membership is of the BPA is non-refundable and non transferable.
