The Centre offers you complete training and facilities to Championship Level, we will safely train and guide you through the extremely thorough introduction, to the theory & practical techniques that will enable you to enjoy your very 1st Solo Skydive. The equipment you will use is the latest, most up to date square parachuting systems available today, with both Main and Reserve parachutes packed neatly into a single container, worn on your back. Altogether the equipment is worth in excess of £2500.



An unquestionable level of safety is offered to you with an extremely high standard of instruction. This is governed by the British Parachute Association (BPA). Known as RAPS (Ram Air Progression System), your course will take a minimum of 6 hours initial ground training, followed by your 1st Skydive from 3,500ft (weather permitting). Your main parachute is opened automatically by use of a Static Line, which is attached to the aircraft, so all you have to do is **JUMP** and enjoy yourself.

Due to the exceptional performance of the parachute systems we operate, you will be able to make further skydives in accordance with the British Parachute Association Category System and you soon could be progressed to your very 1st Freefall Descent. All additional training after your 1st Skydive is **FREE** all you have to do is pay for a jump ticket. Ancillary equipment such as jumpsuit, helmet and altimeter will be provided. You may wear training shoes for your Skydive on this type of parachute equipment.

Skydiving has its restrictions and unfortunately we can't train anyone who is:-

- Under 16 years of age.
- Persons over 16 but under 18 years of age must have written parental/guardian consent.
- Any person over the age of 55.
- Any person over 15 stone in weight fully clothed. Should your Body Mass Index (BMI) not be in proportion to your weight and height you are at more risk of suffering an injury. Please note: You will be weighed to ensure this requirement is adhered to.

Any person involved with parachuting should have a reasonable high standard of physical fitness. All persons must sign a fitness to parachute medical declaration form, and if aged 40 years or over this must be signed and stamped by your G.P.

*In the interest of **SAFETY** if you are unable to absorb the training and / or can't react safely to any given situation that you are taught, your Instructor reserves the right to refuse anyone from making their 1st Static Line Skydive.*

The cost of your training course covers :

- All Instruction
- Hire of club equipment
- Provisional 12 month membership of the British Parachute Association.
- Automatic Activation Devices fitted on all equipment.
- Third Party Insurance cover of £2,000,000.
- Radio Communication with an Instructor.
- 1st Jump Certificate

All training courses are held over a weekend. They start @ 8.30 prompt on a Saturday morning . Courses can be run on a Sunday but require a minimum number of 4 people. Should you arrive late for your course, your instructor reserves the right not to allow you or your group to join the remainder of the tuition. This is dependant upon how far the course has advanced and is for safety purposes only. The course fee is in respect to your training as your first Skydive is **FREE**.



As you may be aware Skydiving is a very weather dependant and can only take place under controlled conditions, therefore you may not be able to make your 1st Skydive on the same day or that weekend. Please be prepared to spend time at the Centre to make your 1st or any subsequent Skydives. We will try our best to get you in the air but safety is our most important factor. During cold weather months warm clothing is essential but it must not be restrictive. You may return any weekend should you not complete you descent.

If you enrol for a course and you are unable to attend please call the Centre as soon as possible. Should you wish to re-arrange your course, seven days notice is required, or you may incur administration charges for re-booking.

STATICLINE PARACHUTING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please review our terms and conditions before booking your training and jump or before purchasing flight tickets. If you make a booking or perform any other transaction with NWPC Ltd (Skydive Northwest) either directly or through an agent, you will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions and they form the basis of your contract with NWPC Ltd (Skydive Northwest).

- A booking, once made is final and all deposits are NON Refundable. Balance of payment is due on or before the day of the course. Once paid monies are non refundable for any reason. You will not be allowed to change the date with less than 21days notice and a £15.00 admin fee will be charged for changing the date once agreed. Anyone failing to turn up on the day of their booking will lose the value of the deposit paid.
- The centre reserves the right to cancel and / or re-arrange any pre booked course subject to minimum numbers not being attained, aircraft maintenance or staff shortages or for any other reason. You must comply with the Centre's rules for your own safety. Suitability of any person jumping will be made by the Chief Instructor at the centre and being accepted for training does not entitle you to jump from an aircraft if we deem you to be unfit or in any way unsuitable.
- If taking part in RAPS or AFFF training please study the height/weight chart on your medical declaration form, as persons unfit or over weight relative to their height cannot be accepted for training.
- If bad weather prevents you jumping a refund will not be given. You will be offered a new date to try and jump which is mutually convenient. It will be up to you to return to the centre on another occasion or occasions to complete your jump. In case of bad weather, you will be rebooked at no additional cost.
- If you arrive without paperwork in order, i.e. over the weight limit, or declaration of fitness not stamped, you will not be allowed to jump and the you may forfeit your activity and all monies paid. No alcohol must be consumed before or while training or before skydiving.
- Gift receipts maybe transferred on approval by the centre but **not refundable**. Once a gift receipt has been issued you have twelve months to redeem it. If it is not redeemed within the twelve month period the gift will no longer be valid. A £50.00 fee is charged to extend any gift receipt for a maximum of 6 months. If you book a date to redeem your gift receipt and don't turn up for your course, the gift will be deemed used
- If booking as a group and some of the group don't turn up on the day, deposits are not transferable and the non group price will be charged. If you fail to turn up on the day of your course you will still be liable for the balance of payment.
- Any person attending to undertake any training course and subsequent jump must become a member of the British Parachute Association (BPA). The membership is for 12 months and provides legal liability cover for **Third Party Risks Only** and provides no cover for personal accident, injury or death. Once purchased membership is of the BPA is non-refundable and non transferable.
